Questionnaire for Animal Health Certificate

Pets travelling to the EU or Ireland now require an Animal Health Certificate unless they hold a valid EU passport. UK passports are no longer valid.

Pets must be microchipped and have a valid Rabies vaccination given at least 3 weeks prior to travel.

The Animal Health Certificate must be issued within 10 days of travel (or within 2-5 days for travel to Ireland, Malta, Norway or Finland at which point a tape worming treatment is administered).

Owners must be prepared to sign a declaration stating that they are not travelling abroad with a view to selling or transferring ownership of their pet(s).
